

CPT Codes and Reimbursement ECG

The following list is a representation of commonly used CPT codes for various electrocardiograph procedures and the national cap Medicare reimbursement for tests performed. 93040	Rhythm ECG	One to three leads; with interpretation and report	\$14
93041	Rhythm ECG	One to three leads; tracing only, without interpretation and report	\$6
93042	Rhythm ECG	One to three leads; interpretation and report only	\$8
