Return On Investment

CPT CODE: 95909 (Nerve Conduction Study - 5-6 units)

Based on AMA guidelines, and the AASEM, the recommended billing is for 95909, which is equivalent to the expired 95904 x 12 units. Even though most exams require the testing of more nerves, they are necessary as controls and provide the diagnostic sensitivity of the Pain NCS study. (Some practices bill 95912 [11-12 nerves] successfully.)

CPT CODE: 95925 (SSEP; Somatosensory Evoked Potential)

Based on AMA guidelines, and the AASEM, each Axon II study bills for SSEP; 95925 for CERVICAL tests or 95926 for LUMBAR tests.

(Based on 50% Medicare – 50% Other Insurance)
